A combined offer from two needle mills: a tour of the historic Forge Mill Needle Museum to discover the fascinating story of how a needle was made in Victorian times- then onto a factory that once made surgical needles.

This building is now home to the Inkberrow Design Centre who offer an extensive variety of textile related courses.



Here you can have a go at a 'taster' workshop- from beading, embellishing, felting, card making or simply watch a demonstration. The premises also houses a lively and thriving craft centre for you to enjoy and not forgetting the Crafty Café, which serves delicious home-made food.

A suggested itinerary  
(but it can be tailored to your group's needs):

- Arrive at the Forge Mill Needle Museum - tea and cake on arrival
- Welcome and guided tour of Forge Mill (approx. 1 hour)
- Time to enjoy the current exhibition and museum grounds, Visitor Centre and Shop (approx. 1 hour)
- Leave Forge Mill for Britten Street (approx. 5 mins distance)

- Lunch at the Crafty Café (cold buffet)
- Workshop participation or demonstration (1 hour)
- Free time to enjoy the craft centre
- Leave for home

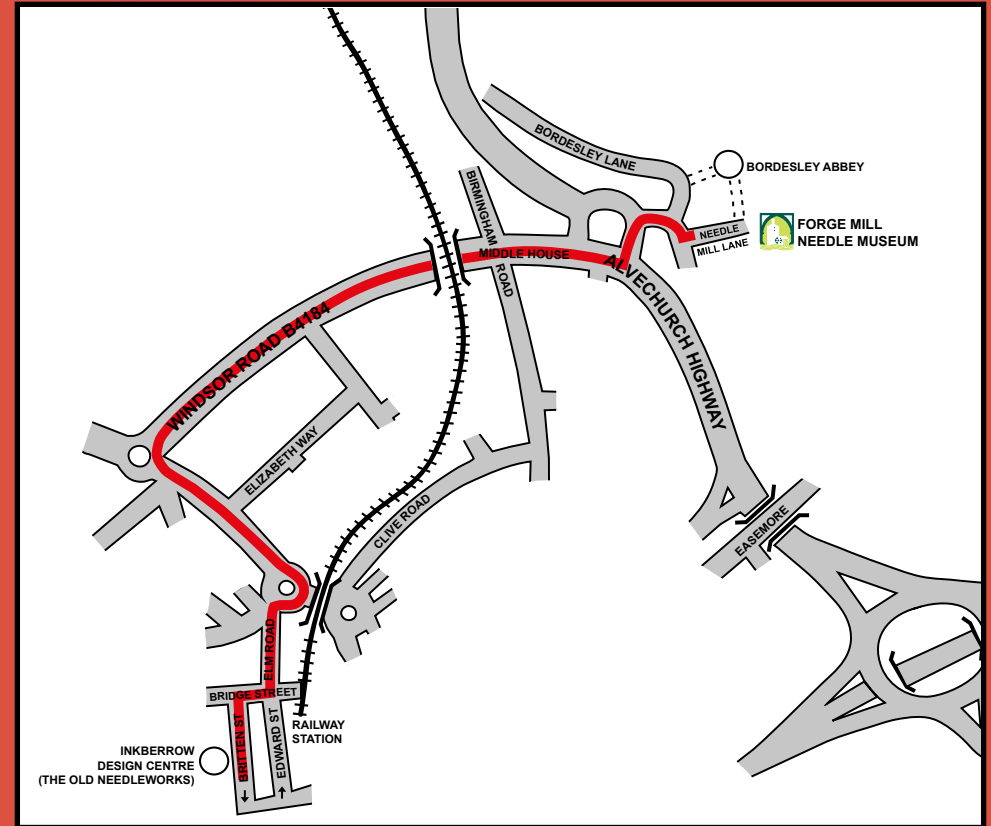
